You don't have to live in the Gallinas Creek watershed to take the survey. GCW is interested in reaching everyone who spends time in the area: those who live here, work here, go to school here, or shop/visit often, etc. In order to get past question 1 - "please identify the watershed you live in or visit often", please check "Gallinas creek" in order to proceed through the survey.

Marin County is leading efforts in conjunction with partner agencies and stakeholders in numerous watersheds throughout the county and preliminary discussions are underway about a similar program in the Las Gallinas watershed. Future work is contingent upon funding support and authorization from the local agencies.
