

Peacock Gap Golf and Country Club Gets A Breather

On December 8 the City of San Rafael Planning Department held a public hearing to determine if the City should extend the Environmental and Design Review Permit approved by the City Council in 2008, relating to the planned changes to the PGGCC's main clubhouse and the addition of a pool and spa.

Present at the hearing were representatives from the previous and prospective golf course management, a golf course employee and four members of the public, including two PGHA Board members.

After accepting comments, Acting Zoning Administrator Steve Stafford allowed a two-year extension. This move will give the prospective owners an additional two years to acquire the grading and building permits for the project, rather than having to engage in another lengthy environmental review process prior to making their planned upgrades to the course and the driving range services building.
