MEDIAN IMPROVEMENTS COMING SOON

The San Rafael City Council approved a resolution at the October 5th Council meeting authorizing an agreement with the Peacock Gap Homeowner's Association (PGHA) to construct and maintain the medians in Peacock Gap. The City Public Works Department staff prepared the resolution, and both the Assistant Public Works Director and the City Manager urged the Council to vote for approval (see the Resolution icon on the [Medians Improvement Committee](#) page to read the entire document).

The PGHA Board was in attendance and President Greg Faulkner spoke to the Council, giving a brief history of the efforts of the Board and the Medians Committee over the past several years to try to bring this project to the City Council for approval. Other Board members also spoke in favor. A few homeowners spoke in opposition, and urged the City Council to vote no on the resolution, or go back to the drawing board. In the end, the City Council voted to approve the resolution so the project to improve the medians will now go forward.

Next steps: The City will sign off on the resolution and the Medians Committee will meet with City Public Works staff to review the landscaping plans to be sure they are in order. Then bids for the capital improvements will be solicited. Maintenance contract bids will be solicited in the future.
